Spartanburg County Council met on Monday, October 18, 2021, at 4:15 p.m. in Conference Room Two of the County Administrative Office Building.  - D. Receipt of legal advice subject to attorney-client privilege regarding the consolidation of the Croft and Roebuck Fire Departments.


Motion seconded by Mr. Mabry and carried.
